## Security update

### Increased security at Terraces and live status GSM modules for all estates

Following the security incident at the Terraces, a double electric fence barrier has been erected leading from the guard house to the top corner of Terraces and barbwire has been installed at the top corner to better close off the blind corner. In addition, a beam system has been installed for early detection as well as a patrol clock point at the top corner for the night patrols.





To further enhance our security, live status GSM modules have been installed on all the energizers of the WBHOA estates, which are monitored via cell phone apps.

## ALERT with regard to tailgating

In the *Pretoria East REKORD* of 28 May 2021, the so-called "tailgating" robberies came under the spotlight again after another incident at a security complex in Waterkloof where a 66-year-old lady was targeted and robbed upon returning to the complex from an outing to Brooklyn Mall. As she entered the complex on High Street, the car with the robbers slipped in behind them, parking in the middle of the entrance to manipulate the sensor and prevent the gate from closing.

Residents should please be alert and vigilant when entering the estate. Tailgating is a concern and although security tries to be vigilant at best, we need our residents to be vigilant as well. Not only should residents be vigilant at the estate but also when going and returning from the mall and/or visiting family/friends.



#### Upcoming holidays

With the upcoming winter holidays, the WBHOA would, once again, like to request all residents to be vigilant and to make sure that alarms and electric fences are armed; windows and doors are closed and locked; and suspicious activity is reported immediately to the security supervisor at 076 801 6418.

If you are going to be away, please also inform your neighbours who will be here, to be on the lookout and ensure that you can disarm an alarm that was triggered by accident in your absence.
